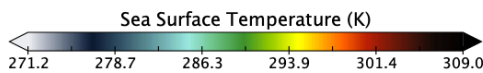
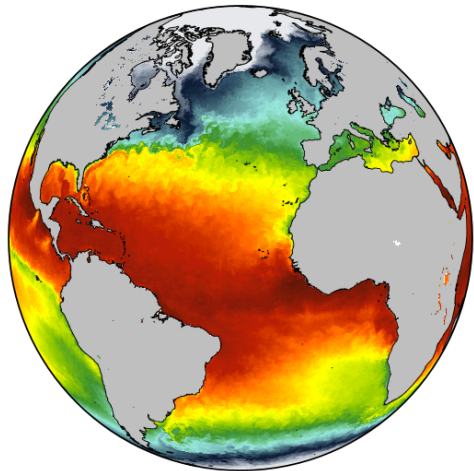




VACANCY: RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP AT ISMAR-CNR

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:



The Istituto di Scienze Marine, Consiglio Nazionale delle Ricerche (ISMAR-CNR) in Rome, Italy, offers a research fellowship within the framework of the Copernicus Marine Service – Sea Surface Temperature Thematic Assembly Centre (SST-TAC). The fellowship involves research activities in three key areas:

1. Operational production and validation of Sea Surface Temperature (SST) products for the Mediterranean and Black Sea, distributed through SST-TAC.
2. Development of novel marine environment monitoring products, potentially for integration into the Copernicus Programme in the future.
3. Analysis of observational and model time series to investigate climate variability and its influence on the marine environment and global climate.

The selected candidate will work within an international and interdisciplinary setting, with an emphasis on disseminating their findings through scientific publications, project reports, and presentations at national and international scientific meetings.

RESEARCH AREA: Earth/Environmental Sciences/Remote Sensing/Oceanography

CONTRACT DURATION: 12 months, renewable.
